

### **Equal Pay Claims**




### Coates v. Farmers Group, Inc. et al.

- Discrimination class action lawsuit brought by 300 female attorneyemployees.
- Alleged that they were paid less than their male counterparts for doing the same work.
- Farmers will pay \$4M.
  \$2 million in attorney fees and costs.



### Netflix 2012 Settlement



- NAD sued Netflix under the ADA because they did not have closed captioned on their website.
- U.S. District Court in Massachusetts ruled that the statute should read to include the Internet as a place of public accommodation.

# Who is a Joint Employer & Employer?

- The NLRB is deciding if McDonald's is a joint employer of franchise employees.
- Uber settlement was \$100M.



### **Expansion of LGBT Rights**

Although there have been local and regional laws passed to expand anti-discrimination language to include protections for sexual orientation or gender identity, there hasn't been movement in Congress, where the Employment Nondiscrimination Act is in limbo.

The EEOC has issued administrative rulings and in 2016 will push to enforce protections.
